It was the US war against Iraq, and the war against Syria led by the US, Saudi Arabia and Turkey, which paved the way for the emergence of ISIS. Turkey, with a government led by the Islamist AKP, had agreed in 2003 to allow the US to use military bases in Turkey in the US war on Iraq. Later, the AKP government sent proxy groups of terrorists to Syria as part of the effort by Islamists and imperialism to topple the secular, Arab nationalist Syrian state. Many of the jihadis from Libya and Europe who were welcomed into Turkey as part of the war on Syria

went on to join ISIS.

With Kurdish forces playing a major role in the fight against ISIS in Syria, pro-Kurdish organisations such as the People's Democratic Party (HDP) – formed by left-leaning political organisations with pro-Kurdish views – became a target of attack for both the AKP and ISIS. The policies of the Erdogan-led AKP government – including majoritarian attacks on minority Kurds – continue to wreak havoc in Turkey.

The attack by ISIS failed to crush Lisa Çalan's spirit. After much hardship and struggles, she began to walk using prosthetic legs, and returned to filmmaking. Her 2016 film *Zimanê Çîya* (*The Tongue of the Mountains*) is scheduled to be screened at the 26th IFFK, on 19 March 2022.

### Rehana Mariam Noor A conflicting

A conflicting outlook on women life

### Opening Film

The 26th International Film Festival of Kerala is opening with a neighbourhood film. *Rehana* is a Bangladeshi film directed by writer and filmmaker Abdullah Mohammad Saad. Released in 2021, this film opens up a wide outlook on women's life from a powerful feminist point of view.

Rehana has already caught the world's film eye by becoming the first Bangladeshi film to be screened at the Cannes Film Festival. The plot of the film revolves around Rehana Mariam Noor, an assistant professor at a private medical college, who goes through the hardened and conditioned conflicts arising from her family. The film shows her struggle to balance her personal and professional life in a strictly patriarchal society. At the age of 38, Rehana has to play the roles of a teacher, doctor, sister, daughter and mother. She is a character who strictly wants to stand for justice and fair treatment, but her actions are often deterred by the prejudices and stereotypes of society. Rehana fights for justice for her six-year-old daughter and her student who are facing violent oppressions from the dominating male chauvinistic community. It puts forward the high end need for a change in the thought process and freedom for women in the 21st century.

The role of Rehana is played by notable Bangladeshi actress Azmeri Haque Badhon. Badhon, who has been into acting since 2006, is also a dentist. In an interview, director



Abdullah Mohammad Saad said that he was lucky to get the actress to play Rehana and that she portrayed the role with extraordinary dedication. Badhon won the Asia Pacific Screen Award for Best Actress in 2021 for her performance in *Rehana*.

Rehana is Abdullah Mohammad Saad's second film as a director. His first film was Live from Dhaka which was released in 2016. Live from Dhaka won him the Best Director Award at the 27th Singapore International Film Festival. The filmmaker believes that the secret to a better life is to move forward boldly. He comes from a family with three older sisters and so was well aware of women's conflicts in today's society. Abdullah says that's how Rehana came into reality.

The International Film Festival of Kerala has always taken it to celebrate the makers of the cultural, social and political artform called cinema. The 26th edition of the festival has dedicated an entire section to the world renown Portuguese filmmaker Miguel Gomes under the category 'Sublime Fantasia'. It is a compilation of artful aesthetic films incorporated perfectly into a political and cultural amalgamation. Gomes has directed and co-written the screenplays of all these films.

Miguel Gomes was born in 1972 in Lisbon, Portugal. Gomes initially worked as a film critic and author of theoretical writings on cinema after he trained at the Escola Superior de Teatro e Cinema (Superior School of Theatre and Film, Lisbon). His film *Tabu* was a winner of the Alfred Bauer Prize for Artistic Innovation and the FIPRESCI Jury Prize at the 2012 Berlin International Film Festival. His *Arabian Nights* (2015) was screened as part of the Directors' Fortnight section at the 2015 Cannes Film Festival.

Gomes is well known for his strong political stance that he sets up in a well defined and aesthetic background of narration and storytelling. The incorporation of his powerful perspectives into his cultural works have been acknowledged and often severely condemned. He integrates art, culture and politics in a perfectly blended concoction that appeals to an audience with an eye for good films.

The list of Miguel Gomes films in the 'Sublime Fantasia' category include Arabian Nights Volume 1: The Restless One, Arabian Nights Volume 2: The Desolate One, Arabian Nights Volume 3: The Enchanted One, Our Beloved Month of August, Tabu, The Face You Deserve, and The Tsugua Diaries.


